Event Information

Venue

Aquatic & Recreation Centre Boundary Road, Ooralea Mackay

Entrants

The Meet is open to Swimming North Queensland and Far North Queensland registered athletes only, as per Swimming Queensland Regional Championship policy.

Age

Age group of athletes for the meet is the age as at the first day of competition (i.e. 1 March 2024). The minimum age is 8 years for both Individual and Relay events. Athletes are not permitted to 'swim up' in individual events. Athletes are not permitted to 'swim up" in relay events.

Rules

Except for the special conditions listed herewith, the Championships are conducted under the Swimming Rules and the By-Laws of Swimming Australia Ltd (SAL) and by permission of Swimming Queensland (SQ). The competition will be always under the direction of the Technical Manager. Any protests are to be in writing accompanied by a \$100 fee lodged with the Race Referee within thirty (30) minutes of the completion of the respective event.

In nominating for these Championships, athletes agree they may be photographed by SNQ's approved photographer and that images may be used by Swimming NQ for its website, publications and or social media.

Late Entries

All entries submitted after closing date will incur a late entry fee. Late entries will be accepted up to thirty (30) minutes prior to start of competition and are subject to lane availability. Proof of entry qualifying time will be required and will be verified on Results Central.

Entry Times & Qualifying Times

Entries for both individual and relay events **will not** be accepted without an entry time. Where qualifying times apply, entry times must meet the qualifying time.

All entry times must have been swum since 1 January 2023.

Athletes must have swum a qualifying time for their age to enter in these events.

N.B. NO TIME (NT) WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR ANY EVENT/ENTRY.

Racing Format and Medals

All 200m, 400m, 800m and 1500m, and the 8-12yrs 50m and 100m events will be conducted as timed finals. All other events will be conducted as Heats and Finals.

For 50m events, Heats will be swum in combined age groups (13yrs & over), and 100m events, heats will be swum in combined age groups (13 yrs., 14yrs and 15yrs & over) with Finals swum in the following age groups: 13yrs, 14yrs, 15yrs, 16yrs, 17yrs & over.

Medals will be awarded as follows:

8–9yrs 50 metre events (No points) – **8-9 yrs are a Combined Age Group**. (includes first 3 SNQ athletes) Medals will not be awarded if qualifying times have not been met. Points are awarded to 8th place in the Timed Finals or Finals.

Relay Events

Relay team entries are to be completed through Swim Central. Payment may be made in Swim Central using a debit/credit card, OR teams may be submitted as 'Pending' via Swim Central and an invoice will be issued.

All relays shall consist of 4 competitors in the appropriate gender. Mixed Relays shall consist of 2 males and 2 females. All other relay changes will close as a time posted in the program.

NQ Relay Changes -

Any alterations to originally - submitted relay teams with the addition of reserves must be submitted 1hr prior to commencement of session time.

Athletes with Impairment Events

There are no specific Multi Class Events. Multiclass swimmers may enter in their respective age group events and are required to provide proof of classification to the Technical Manager prior to the start of the meet.

Medals will be awarded for placings 1st 2nd & 3rd to Athletes with an Impairment who have provided proof of classification.

Entry to events with a qualifying time will need to be emailed to <u>snqracesecretary@gmail.com</u> for manual entry as the qualifying times will not apply, however the athlete must still have a time to enter.

Warm – up Procedures

Swimmers are required to be under the supervision of a coach or team manager during the warmup/ down period.

The competition pool may be used for warm up, until 15 minutes prior to racing commencing. The 25m pool will be in use for the duration of the meet. Competitors must comply with signage on pool deck regarding the use of the warmup and warm down lanes. Diving will not be permitted unless the signage indicates otherwise.

Entry List

The entry list will be provided to all competitors and made available on our <u>website</u>. All competitors must check their entries thoroughly and if any discrepancies are noted they must be submitted using swim central by Midnight, Sunday 25 February.

Timekeeper Roster

A timekeeper roster will be confirmed and published on our <u>website</u> the Thursday prior to the Championships.

Timeline

The timeline for this meet will be published on our <u>website</u> on the Thursday prior to the Championships. The timeline is to be used as a guide only and actual start times of events may, vary depending on a variety of circumstances on the actual day of competition.









Online Program

An online program will be published on our <u>website</u> on Thursday 29 February. No printed programs will be available.

Marshalling Procedures

Relay Marshalling

Guided marshalling will be in place for Relays.

Heats & Finals Marshalling

Self-Marshalling will be in place for the Heats Sessions and Timed Finals, with guided marshalling in place for the Finals Sessions. Swimmers should ensure they're in the designated marshalling area when informed by the Announcer.

Swimmers competing in the first event of any session should ensure they're in the designated marshalling area at least 10 minutes prior to the start of a session.

Swimmers in 400m, 800m & 1500m events may be amalgamated on the day by the Technical Manager depending on the numbers of nominated swimmers.

N.B. - Attention Coaches and Team Managers – It is your responsibility to ensure that your Club swimmers are in the designated marshalling area when required. "Late Arrivals" will be taken to the Session Referee who will make the final decision if the swimmer/s in question competes.

Time Trials

Time Trials may be considered for those swimmers who are attending the Swimming Australia Age & Multi Class Championships, 6th -14th April 2024, and or the Swimming Australian Open Championships, 17th -20th April 2024, and require a qualifying time in the following distances – 50m, 100m and 200m. (Application Form attached for inclusion in the SNQ Championships Programme).

SNQ CLUB AVERAGE POINTS AWARD

Awarded to the NQ Club, with the HIGHEST average points per nominated swimmer in the Individual Championship Events.

SNQ GRAND PARADE AWARD

To be awarded to the best presented NQ Team in the Grand Parade. Winner to be judged by a panel of three consisting of 2 invited guests, plus President or Vice President. Judge's decision will be final. No protest or correspondence will be entered into.

Other Competitor Guidance Notes

• Athletes are not permitted to 'swim up' an age.

• Heats are seeded fastest to slowest. Heats may be amalgamated or re-seeded at the discretion of the Technical Manager and Referee.

• Starts will be 'over the top'. Competitors will remain in their respective lanes until the next Heat is Started.

• Any competitor who qualifies in the top 12 placegetters for the Final of an event not wishing to compete in the Final must complete and submit a withdrawal form to the control room (either personally, or through his/her authorised representative) within 30 minutes of the posting of the results of the specific event.

• Any competitor who qualifies in the top 12 placegetters for the Final, following withdrawals is required for the Final (which includes reserves), and does not marshal for the event shall be fined the sum of \$50, except where there are medical reasons or proven hardship. The Technical Manager shall determine the acceptability on all matters where medical reasons or hardship are claimed, and his/her determination shall be final.

• Only two announcements will be made in relation to the composition of the final field and reserves: an initial announcement when the field is compiled and a second announcement at the expiration of the 30-minute period, as prescribed by the Rules.

Special Notes

Athletes will marshal using the 'Self Marshalling' Protocols.

All special trophies are open to SNQ Athletes/Teams only.

SNQ Clubs will be rostered for volunteer duties as well as their regular timekeeping duty.

SNQ Clubs will be advised of their volunteer duties after the close of entries.
