CONDITIONS FOR APPLICATION OF A TIME TRIAL:

- Application form to be given to the Technical Manager and or Meet Referee of the day no later than 30 minutes after completion of the event.
- If the meet is a two or more day meet and the event is at the end of the day, the form is to be handed to the Technical Manager/Referee at the start of the next day.
- Time must be swum within:
 - 0.5 (1/2) second for 50m events
 - one (1) second for 100m events & 200m events
- o Swimmer must be already nominated for the event to be considered for a time trial.
- \circ Swimmer that was disqualified in their swim cannot be considered for a time trial.
- \circ Swimmer that did not compete in the event on the day cannot be considered for a time trial.
- \circ $\,$ Only a Coach or Team Manager can place the Application for Consideration.
- o Final decision is at the Technical Manager /Meet Referee's discretion to approve the time trial.
- Technical Manager/Referee will notify the Coach/Team Manager when the Time Trial will be held.

The qualifying times for the Australian Age Swimming Championships must have been achieved at an approved meet in a 50m pool using electronic timing (including SAT) at any time on or after 1 May in the year prior to the year in which the championships are held unless otherwise stated in the event information.
